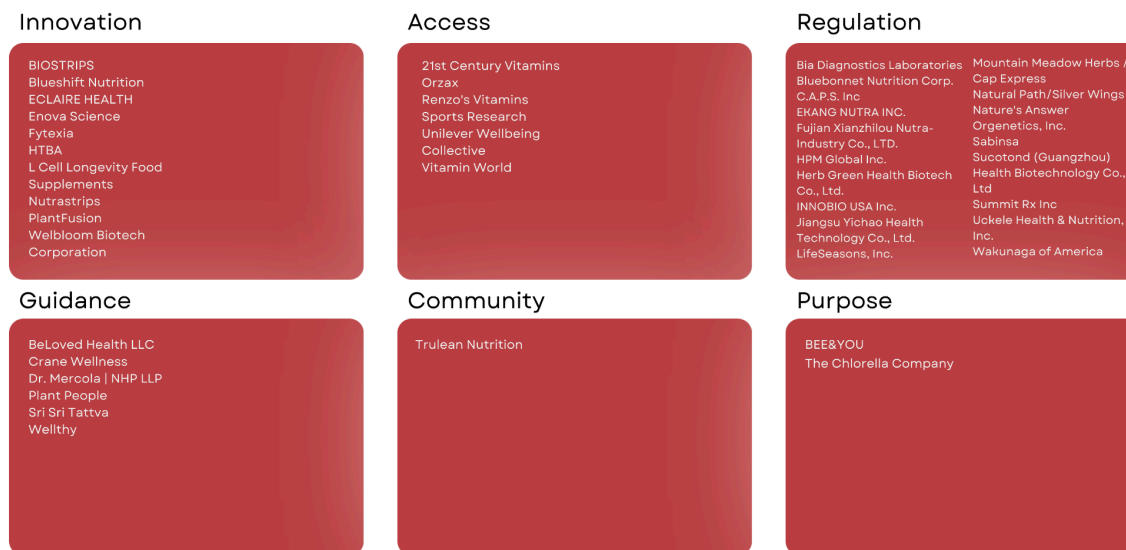

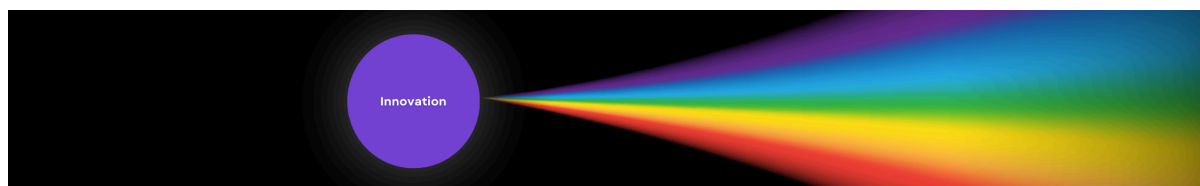
Mapping What's Next in The **Nutraceutical** & Supplement Brands

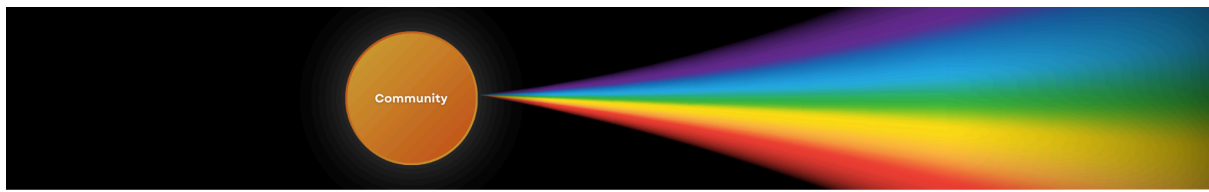
on natural health approaches. They stand out by leveraging a strong personal brand and extensive content to influence supplement choices.

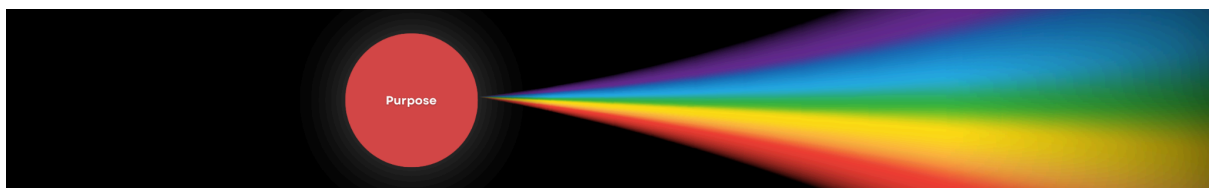
## Concepts from Community

## Top 5 categories attracting capital in 2026

### 1. Collagen Peptides (Collagen 2.0)

- Bioactive peptides for skin elasticity and joint mobility.
- Multi-source blends (marine + bovine) improving absorption.
- Investors see collagen as a beauty-from-within anchor with strong consumer demand.
